

VOTE BY MAIL: SEPTEMBER 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION

With the implementation of the recently-passed VOTES Act, any Massachusetts voter can request a mail-in ballot for any 2022 election. This is just one of the many ways that you can vote this year. Learn how it works below!

JULY 22: APPLICATIONS TO VOTE BY MAIL ARE SENT OUT

Applications for mail-in ballots will be sent to local elections offices by July 22, and will arrive in your mailbox shortly after. Request your mail in ballot **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**.



AUGUST 29: LAST DAY TO REQUEST A MAIL-IN BALLOT

You can track your ballot requested by mail through the state's website. Ballots will be mailed out beginning in mid-August, continuing as applications arrive, until the August 29 deadline.



SEPTEMBER 6: YOUR BALLOT MUST REACH LOCAL ELECTION OFFICE BY 8 P.M.

Submit your completed ballot **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**. You can mail the ballot to the address on the envelope, or if you want to submit your ballot in person, there will also be dedicated ballot drop boxes available in your city.
