

VOTE BY MAIL: NOVEMBER 2022 STATE ELECTIONS

With the implementation of the recently-passed VOTES Act, any Massachusetts voter can request a mail-in ballot for any 2022 election. This is just one of the many ways that you can vote this year. Learn how it works below!

NOVEMBER 1: LAST DAY TO REQUEST A MAIL-IN BALLOT

You can track your ballot requested by mail through the state's website. Ballots will be mailed out beginning in mid-October, continuing as applications arrive, until the November 1 deadline.



NOVEMBER 8: YOUR BALLOT MUST BE POSTMARKED BY ELECTION DAY

Submit your completed ballot **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**. Mailed ballots received after 8 p.m. on Election Day can only be counted if they are postmarked by Election Day. Ballots returned in person or by drop box must be delivered by 8 p.m. on Election Day.



NOVEMBER 11: YOUR BALLOT MUST REACH YOUR LOCAL ELECTION OFFICE BY 5PM

Ballots returned by mail from inside the United States must reach your local election office by 5 p.m. on November 11, 2022, in order to be counted. You can track your ballot using the Track My Ballot tool, available on the Secretary of State's website.
