



Massachusetts Ballot Measure Guide 2018

What does a **YES** or **NO** vote mean on each question?

Question 1: Nurse-Patient Assignment Limits Initiative (full text)	YES	A YES vote would establish limits on the number of patients assigned to registered nurses working in hospitals
	NO	A NO vote would keep things the way they are, with no legal limits set to how many patients a nurse can be assigned
Question 2: Advisory Commission for Amendments to the U.S. Constitution Regarding Corporate Personhood and Political Spending Initiative (full text)	YES	A YES vote would establish a 15-member citizens' commission to advocate for certain amendments to the United States Constitution regarding campaign finance and corporate personhood
	NO	A NO vote would <i>not</i> establish the commission
Question 3: Gender Identity Anti-Discrimination Veto Referendum (full text)	YES	A YES vote would support and uphold as law a bill to prohibit discrimination based on gender identity in public places—such as hotels, restaurants, and stores.
	NO	A NO vote would repeal the law designed to prohibit discrimination based on gender identity in public places
